



Grand Avenue Road Diet Project

As part of the City of Oakland's ongoing efforts to improve roadway safety and traffic calming, and with City Council approval of the Grand Avenue Road Diet Project in October 2015, the City has contracted with Gallagher & Burk to perform construction work on Grand Avenue in the Cities of Oakland and Piedmont. This notice provides information you may need during the construction work.

As part of this work, the contractor will re-stripe Grand Avenue from 4 travel lanes (2 lanes each way) to 3 travel lanes (one travel lane each way and a two-way left-turn median lane) and Class II bicycle lanes.

The project limits are on Grand Avenue from Elwood Ave in Oakland to Fairview Ave in Piedmont. The project is located in Council District 2.

New striping work will be performed at night time (10:00 PM to 6:00 AM) to avoid impacts to daytime vehicular traffic flow. Noise from night time work will be minimal and is not expected to be disruptive to residents. Pavement asphalt work will be performed during daytime (9:00 AM to 4:00 PM) as warmer weather is required for the asphalt mix to set.

The contractor will set up advance warning signs, barricades, delineators, traffic cones, flaggers, and crossing guards for lane closures and traffic detouring, and to ensure safety for all users.

This project is funded by Measure BB Sales Tax.

- Construction will be from April 29, 2016 through May 11, 2016.
- One travel lane each way will remain open during construction for vehicular traffic. Lane closure and traffic detouring will be required.
- Vehicular access to driveways will be maintained at all times.
- Bus stops and sidewalks will be open and accessible to pedestrians at all times.
- On-street parking restrictions will be required during construction. No parking signs will be posted in advance of start date of construction.

Should the construction schedule be delayed, you will receive an updated notice.

City of Oakland staff will be monitoring this construction project to ensure that it meets project plans and specifications.
