HOW CAN WE HELP YOU?

There are many ways Supervisor Carson's office can assist residents of District 5 in Alameda County, which includes the cities of **Albany, Berkeley, Emeryville, Piedmont, and parts of Oakland**. Please do not hesitate to reach out to us for any of the following:

Agency Assistance: Navigating government agencies and services can be daunting. If you are having trouble with any Alameda County agency-related issue (i.e. Social Services, Aging and Adult Services, Public Health, Child Support Services, Public Works, Housing and Community Development, etc.), we can help try to resolve your matter or get you the information you need.

Referrals: Although we can only directly intervene in county-related matters, we never want to leave you without help. If you are not sure where to get assistance for your issue, give us a call – we can direct you to the appropriate government office or community organization.

Keeping You Informed: If you want to be in the know about important county information and resources, the latest news from the Supervisor, and the many events taking place in and around the district, subscribe to our email list, follow Supervisor Carson on Twitter, Facebook, and Instagram. We send out emails weekly and update our social media platforms regularly.
